



I, Andy C. Stephens, being duly sworn on the oath, state that I have good reason to believe, and do believe that on or about the 24 day of MARCH, 2016, in Clay County Texas the defendant committed the offense of POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, TXHSC 481.121, A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR.

My belief is based upon the following facts and information:

On 3/24/16 Ms. Cook TX DL 35926608, was stopped for speeding 89mph in 75mph zone, on US 82 NB near MM 538. As I made contact with the vehicle, I observed the strong smell of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. Ms. Cook was asked to step to the rear of the vehicle. After further investigation Ms. Cook admitted to having the marijuana in the vehicle. After a probable cause search of the vehicle. I located a bag of marijuana, and drug paraphernalia- a grinder, rolling papers, in the center consol. A glass pipe was found between the driver seat and the console next to the seatbelt. Ms. Cook admitted the pipe had THC Oils inside. Ms. Cook was placed under arrest for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of a Controlled Substance. Ms. Cook was secured in my front passenger seat with the seatbelt and double locked handcuffs. The marijuana and other evidence was placed in the rear passenger seat. While I was outside the vehicle Ms. Cook had secured the marijuana, when I returned the my seat I observed Ms. Cook chewing/ swallowing what was later discovered as the marijuana from the rear seat. Ms. Cook was transported to the Clay County jail and released to the jail staff.
